# electrypnoseSync 1.0.0

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## Installation

### macOS

Double click on Setup electrypnoseSync 1.0.0.pkg and follow the on-screen instructions. After clicking Install you will be prompted for your user password to complete the installation.


### Windows

Double click on Setup electrypnoseSync 1.0.0.exe

When asked by User Account Control if you "want to allow this app to make changes to your device?", click Yes then follow the on-screen instructions.

## Registration

After purchasing a license for electrypnoseSync or the Everything Bundle, please check your email for the registration keys (the email will be from FastSpring if you purchased from bomshankamachin.es, please check in your Spam folder if you cannot immediately find it), you can also find your license details from the user account area of our website. After opening the plugin in your DAW, click on the "burger" menu<sup>1</sup> and choose Registration or click on the "Unregistered" text at the top left of the plugin.

Now enter the Name, Email and License fields exactly as shown in the email you received, finally click OK. Upon successful registration you will be shown a confirmation message, and the plugin will show "Registered" on the user interface temporarily when the plugin starts.

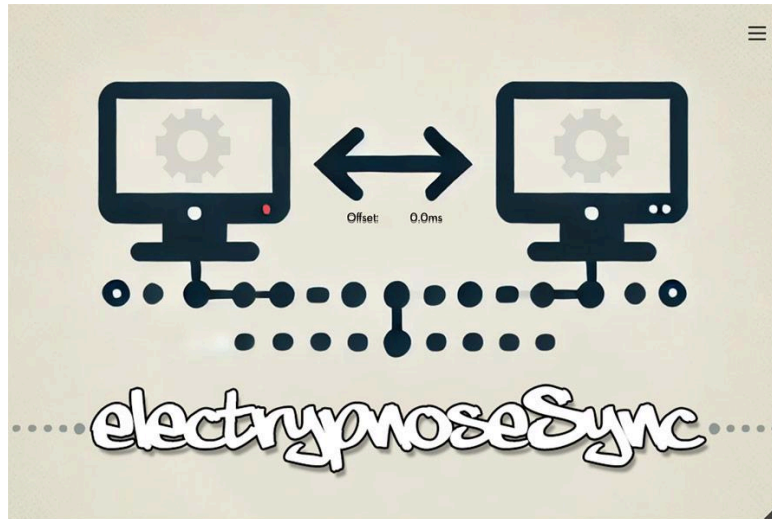

## Using electrynoseSync

1. Add electrynoseSync to your master inserts<sup>2</sup>
2. Start another Ableton Link enabled application and enable its Link option
3. ???
4. Profit

When the plugin is started and no other Ableton Link peers are found the plugin looks like this:



Once you start another Ableton Link enabled application on the same network/machine then the cogs on each display become darker to signify there is a connection established, during playback they will spin.

If you need to manually adjust the time offset between your host and other Link peers you can use the Offset control located underneath the arrows between each display by clicking and dragging up/down. Double clicking will allow you to enter an offset value. Right clicking on the Offset control will show a context menu giving the options to reset the offset to 0ms as well as nudging the offset by 1/16, 1/8 or 1/4 increments forwards or backwards in time. This can be useful when you've got the timing correct except for the beat alignment.

## Caveat emptor

This plugin is abusing the Ableton Link protocol and is only meant for very specific use cases, it cannot allow the hosting application to adjust its own synchronisation to match other peers on the network, instead it provides a method for applications that can synchronise themselves to stay in sync with an application that normally doesn't support Ableton Link.
